DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Follow the recommendations of the most restrictive active ingredient product label. Tank mixtures should only be applied within the product label recommendations of every product in the tank mixture. Tempus DF may be used in terrestrial and aquatic* applications. Consult the relevant aquatic* herbicide for recommendations on use rates. Tempus DF may be applied through direct injection systems when pumped with the proper amount of water. Do not pre-mix with emulsifiable concentrates or aqueous solutions unless used through approved herbicide custom blends.

NOTE: When combining new or unfamiliar components in any tank mix, the applicator should conduct phytotoxicity and jar tests to ensure compatibility and avoid damage to non-targeted species. If the pesticide does not recommend the use of a surfactant and drift control agent, follow the directions below. Use only if a surfactant and/or a drift control agent are allowed and not excluded on the product labels being used.

Order of addition when Tank Mixing

In general, follow the W-A-L-E-S plan when adding herbicides to a tank mix.

1. Wettable Powders (WP) then Dry Flowables (F,DF)
2. Agitate then add adjuvants such as anti-foaming compounds or buffering agent
3. Liquid and Soluble products
4. Emulsifiable Concentrates (EC)
5. Surfactants or other adjuvants

Prior to mixing you should fill the spray tank at least half full of the carrier, usually water. Next, start the sprayer and check to make sure that all valves and gauges work and that there is proper tank agitation.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Tempus DF is a surfactant blend engineered to enhance the effectiveness and activity of herbicides. It is designed to improve spray droplet deposition, leaf penetration, and reduce drift by producing a more uniform spray pattern. The degree of drift hazard varies with the environmental conditions, type of pesticide application, and the vegetation near the treated area. Tempus DF will reduce the likelihood of drift, but not eliminate it completely.

Do not exceed 1% volume per volume. Droplet spectrum is based on wind tunnel testing using a CP™ 11TT type nozzle at the listed rates.
